9.11.4.3 Squadding Draw

- a) The drawing for the Qualification Rounds must be made so that the athletes
 of each country are distributed in such a way that no squad will contain
 more
 than one (1) athlete from each nation (except the World Cup Final and
 Olympic
 Games if necessary);
- b) Three (3) squads in the Men's category and three (3) squads in the Women's category, drawn separately, must be composed of the top 18 athletes registered to compete for the medals in each category, as per ISSF World Ranking at the time of the official arrival day of the event. The rules as specified in a) and c) will be applied also.
- c) The allocation of athletes to the squads and positions within the squads must be
 done by the drawing of lots under the supervision of the Technical
 Delegate(s).
 This may be done with a computer program suited for this purpose; and
- d) The random selection of ranges and the division of the rounds must be made under the supervision of the Technical Delegate(s).

9.11.4.4 Squad Adjustments

The Jury, in conjunction with the Organizing Committee, and with the approval of the Technical Delegate(s), may adjust the draw, but only to ensure that the requirements of the Squadding Draw (9.11.4.3) are met.
