## 3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup Final will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations – Detailed Information is available on the ISSF website <a href="https://www.issf-sports.org">www.issf-sports.org</a>

### NO ranking points will be distributed for the WCF.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, Shotgun and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF WCF. Qualified Range Officials holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

#### Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

### **Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Testing**

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue wearing this clothing for that day of the event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

#### Air or CO<sub>2</sub> Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO<sub>2</sub> cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

#### **Shotgun Equipment**

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial on their marker tapes. Any shooting vest that does not have ISSF seals on the marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-Competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

#### **Cartridges Control**

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50 g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope

must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Before the Final, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridges Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 30 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left and sealed under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridges' controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals (there will be no elimination for 6<sup>th</sup> place; the first elimination will be for 5<sup>th</sup> place).

#### **Colored Wads**

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

## 4. Participation

Athletes qualified in each of the twelve (12) individual Olympic events according to the 2023 ISSF WC Ranking System will be invited to take part in the ISSF World Cup Final. Apart from the qualification system, the three (3) medalists of the ISSF WCH Baku – AZE 2023 will have the right to compete in the ISSF WCF as well as two (2) athletes from the host country for each event.

#### **Individual Events**

10m AR Women, 10m AR Men, 10m AP Women, 10m AP Men, 25m Pistol Women, 25m RFP Men, 50m 3P Women, 50m 3P Men, Skeet Women, Skeet Men, Trap Women, Trap Men.

#### **Super Finals Events**

Super Final 25m RFP, Super Final Skeet and Super Final Trap.

The top 8 athletes of the World Cup Final ranking in 25m RFP and the top 8 athletes (4 Women and 4 Men) in Trap and Skeet will compete in the Super Finals.





#### **RULES:**

#### 25m RFP

• 8 athletes will participate (top 8 from the individual Qualification)


#### Format:

- 2 FP
- 2 Ammunition Area A and B
- 2 Athletes will go forward and shoot together, (one on FP A, the other on FP B).
- After the series of 4 sec. the athletes move back, and the next two athletes will move forward.
- In Rotation, and after 6 series the first elimination will start-7 series next, etc.

## Trap:

# **Starting on Station 1-5**



- Top 8 athletes qualify in bib order as per current format.
- All 8 athletes line up behind shooting station 1 with bib number 8 firing first.
- Athletes fire at 5 targets (2 left, 2 right, 1 straight) and then the lowest score (or highest bib) is eliminated.
- This is repeated until the final 2 athletes determine the winner in the last 5 targets.
- Shoot off at the end of the final if the last 2 athletes are tied.
- 8 Athletes x 5 targets
- 7 Athletes x 5 targets
- 6 Athletes x 5 targets
- 5 Athletes x 5 targets
- 4 Athletes x 5 targets
- 3 Athletes x 5 targets
- 2 Athletes x 5 targets

#### Skeet:

- Top 8 athletes qualify in bib order as per current format.
- All 8 athletes line up behind shooting station 3 with bib number 8 firing first.
- Athletes fire at 4 targets (regular pair & reverse pair) and then the lowest score (or highest bib) is eliminated.
- This is repeated, progressing to stations 4, then 5 then back to 3, etc. until the final 2 athletes determine the winner in the last 4 targets.
- Shoot off at the end of the final if the last 2 athletes are tied.

### **Prize Money**

The winner of the medals in each Olympic Event will receive the World Cup Final Trophy and the following prize money:

1<sup>st</sup> Place – 5000.- € 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 4000.- € 3<sup>rd</sup> Place – 2000.- €

Prizes money will be paid in cash.

Medals ONLY will be awarded to the winners of the Super Finals Events

## 5. Entry Process

All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see: "Summary of Deadlines").

## 6. Immigration and Customs Requirements

#### **Entry Visa**

Nationals from 100 Countries are now eligible for Visa-free entry upon arrival in Qatar without prior arrangements.

The Organizing Committee will assist participants whose nationality needs prior arrangements for the Entry Visa. Kindly fill in the Visa Support Form (**Annex 6**) and return it not later than **18 OCT 2023**.

### **Customs Formalities, Import of Firearms**

A temporary import license will be issued to all participants by the Qatar Ministry of Interior; the Organizing Committee will email the permit to the federation prior to the arrival date. Kindly send to the Organizing Committee the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 5) not later than 18 OCT 2023.

Any request for a change of the firearm details after the deadline must be notified not later than five (5) days prior to the arrival.

Upon arrival, the Organizing Committee airport officers will assist participants in dispatching the Police and Customs formalities. Travelers will meet OC staff at the baggage collection area.

The **Qatari law strictly prohibits taking firearms and ammunition to the hotel**. Upon arrival, firearms and ammunition will be transported by our officers from the airport to the Shooting Complex and back to the airport at the end of the competition.

#### Useful information on the carriage of Firearms on International Flights

As a rule, before issuing any flight ticket the travel agency appointed to book the flights should make sure that both ammunition and the firearms are accepted on board the aircraft till the final destination.

The Approval should appear in the electronic ticket (on the PNR Passengers Name Record) or on a separate message sent to the travel agency by the Airline Company.

The rules governing the carriage of ammunition and firearms are those of the carrier who owns the aircraft therefore, in case of flights made in code-sharing, the approval must come from both companies even if on the ticket the abbreviation of only one Company appears (i.e.: AF-BA-LH-QA, etc.).

Normally, the final decision to accept firearms and ammunition on board comes from the captain/Airline Company, but once you have the "OK" on your flight ticket, the Airline Company is responsible for having your firearms sent to destination.

In case of indirect flights, it is advisable to consider a connection of at least two hours.

Upon landing at the first airport, report to the information counter and make sure that your firearms have arrived and will be taken on board the connecting flight.

Still, in case of indirect flights, <u>avoid booking</u> them with two different Airline Companies as most of the times the firearms will be discharged and let at the first airport and the owners will have to collect them and make a new check-in, provided the local police authorities do not cause problems of licenses. That will probably cost extra security and boarding taxes and sometimes extra baggage fees. If passengers are not informed, they risk arriving at the final destination without knowing that their firearms have not been loaded on the connecting flight and are lying in the previous airport. In many countries even if in transit and the baggage is labeled till destination, the control of firearm is made at the first airport of arrival, and this is why it is advisable to keep the situation under control step by step.

All firearms and ammunition must be declared while making flight reservations and at check-in and follow the procedure reserved to these special articles. It is a big mistake to pack them into normal bags and dispatch them as normal baggage because in case of loss it will be very difficult to find the firearm in a short term and, last but not least, owners will be liable to heavy fines.

Athletes and Officials together (according to gender distribution) will be accommodated in double rooms, except in cases of odd number of participants where single room(s) will be allocated.

#### Travel-Arrival

Arrival in Qatar can be made through **Hamad International Airport** in Doha which offers excellent travel connections with the entire world. Qatar Airways has flights with more than 150 international destinations.

The Organizing Committee will arrange an airport pick-up/transfer service free of charge during the days of the World Cup Final **from 18 to 26 NOV** and participants are requested to submit the arrival and departure details on time (completed official Final Travel Form – **Annex 4**).

In case of early arrival, the pick-up service can be arranged at a charge. Kindly note that assistance at the airport for the firearms will be granted free of charge regardless of the arrival date.

#### **Travel Costs**

Kindly note that the flight tickets for all participating athletes, officials and other accompanying persons will be at participating ISSF Member Federations expenses.

### **Local Transportation – Shuttle Service**

The shuttle service will be provided free of charge for all participants of the World Cup Final between the hotel and the shooting complex starting **from 18 NOV 2023**. A timetable will be published and displayed on the information boards, at the range and at the hotel.

### Storage of Firearm and Ammunition

The **Qatari law strictly prohibits taking firearms and ammunition to the hotel.** Upon arrival, guns and ammunition will be transported by our officers from the airport to the Shooting Complex and back to the airport at the end of the competition. The storage of firearms will be free of charge.

#### **Ammunition**

The customs authorities will allow participating athletes to import all the necessary ammunition that will be used for the competition if the amount of ammunition is declared on the Firearm Form (Annex 5).
